From Your Minister

This month I wanted to use this space to announce, and recruit for, two new ministries that we are beginning at FCCJ. One of them will be seen in action every week, and I'm sure will make a positive impact on our guests. The other will not be seen in action, but hopefully will also be beneficial to our church. One of them requires good people skills, while the other only requires good listening and observation skills. Let's start with the latter. I am in need of a few good men and women to be part of a new unadvertised, top-secret, covert ministry team that will work directly with me, so if your up for the challenge, and are the kind of person who has an eye and ear for detail, have the "gift" of constructive criticism (but without having a negative spirit), and are the kind of person who, without looking back, has already noticed – and cringed at – the fact that I used "your" instead of "you're" above, and that this is a run-on sentence, you're the right person for the job! If I've piqued your curiosity, and you meet the qualifications, contact me. The other new ministry is called Section Hosts. This team will serve to reinforce our Greeter team but in a different way. While the Greeters welcome people as they enter the building or the auditorium, Section Hosts will move around in the auditorium prior to the Sunday worship service, and take more time to talk to people – especially visitors – who are already seated. While we have a very friendly church, and a lot of that happens naturally, there are times when conversations are going on all over the room among our members, while first-time visitors are sitting silently with no one talking to them. The Section Host team will ideally have six people serving each Sunday – two in each of the larger center sections of seats, and one in each of the side sections. We will need a large team of volunteers so we can spread out the rotation. If you've got a friendly, outgoing personality, can commit to being at your section 20 minutes prior to the service when you're scheduled, and want to help the church make a great first impression, join us for a very brief meeting immediately following the worship service on Sunday, March 8. If you're already serving as a Greeter, you can still volunteer to be a Section Host. We'll make sure you're not scheduled to do both the same Sunday. Thanks for being such a great church!
